Adriana Eraso, COhatch Lakeland's Community Manager and "COhatch Mom," sat down with us to talk about how she became one of the most well-known Community Managers in our ecosystem. Adriana joined our team prior to our Lakeland location opening, but her life before COhatch seems like the universe knew she was headed our way well before she did!

Adriana calls herself a "hospitality rat," having spent most of her childhood following her parents around their jobs at the Hyatt Regency in Baltimore for years. "I'd go into work with them and, over time, became fascinated with their world. I was able to travel with them for work and eventually jumped into hospitality when I went to college." After her stint in Miami for college and hotel work, Adriana worked with a local nonprofit, the Cystic Fibrosis Association, and learned the importance of giving back to the community.

After moving back to Central Florida, Adriana began looking for new opportunities back in hospitality. Since then, Adriana has been at COhatch and has become well-known by her community and members.

COhatch members in Lakeland lovingly call Adriana the "COhatch Mom," because Adriana's day-to-day involves helping members with everything they need to drive their business forward. From helping hook up AV systems for virtual meetings to making sure the space is clean and ready for the next group of visitors, Adriana equates her job to having "200 kids that I work with every day, and I say that lovingly, because I treat them with as much attention and care as I do my own child!"



If you know Adriana and ask why she loves her role as Community Manager and what it means to her, you won't be surprised by her answer. Adriana talks a bit more about what her day-to-day looks like, "Sitting at my desk every day, I see everything. But it's more than just keeping our space nice and tidy. I spend a lot of my day checking in with members, making sure they are getting as much out of our community as they possibly can, and focusing on how I can connect them with other members and resources they need to be successful."

Adriana is a pro at creating and engaging her community for a reason. Community has played a huge role in her life and every time you talk with Adriana, you can feel how meaningful it is to be a part of the Lakeland community. Adriana says, "Community has had a significant impact on my life. My family was hit hard by COVID during the pandemic and to come into a workplace where I know everyone has my back – and I have theirs – has helped me get through tough times. These people have become more than just members and coworkers. They're now friends and family."



## Scholar SPOTLIGHT



Wayfinders, an organization located in Charlotte, North Carolina, has been working towards outside equity for children in their community for 30 years. For years, Mollie James and her team have been dedicated to the original mission of Wayfinders founder, Bruce Irons: to get more people outside who don't always have access or the knowledge to do so.

What started as an organization that sent kids to overnight summer camps, has now

become a year-round organization that provides access to nature hikes, canoeing, children's art & performances, and many other outdoor activities for children who haven't had access to nature and community before. Things like free swim lessons, STEM and education opportunities, and mentorship are also a part of the program, which has helped children succeed through their formative years all the way through college.

In 2006, the organization served 18 scholars, but as of next summer, 180 children will be served in some capacity through the Wayfinders program. The goal is to continue to provide resources for kids and young adults who need them to help them succeed through higher education. Mollie and her team are looking for mentors in the Charlotte area who are dedicated to helping their scholars make the most of their time in the program. Interested in supporting children

Wayfinders is currently utilizing hygge locations to collaborate and build community around their programming, so if you're in the area, stop by and learn more about what they do. 
